



Ash Wednesday is the first day of the season of Lent; a period of 40 days which Christians set aside to reflect on how they are following Jesus and to re-commit themselves to Him.

As a sign of their desire to live lives that mirror Jesus' own, Christians often receive the sign of the cross in ash on their foreheads. This is an outward sign of their inner commitment.
